Hello Church Family!

Our Ministry Coordinator asked me to write a general summer update for ya'll and if there's one thing I've learned in ministry it's that you should definitely listen to the Ministry Coordinator (especially when she's your wife!).

It's been a season of change for our church in many ways. This Summer we switched to a merged 10:30 service and, more recently, the Marone family headed south to a new ministry opportunity in Virginia. I'd like to take the opportunity provided by this newsletter to answer some questions that I've heard a few people ask already.

Will we continue with the merged services?

Last Summer, we tried out the merged service idea for almost 2 months and collected feedback from word-of-mouth and from a congregation survey. The feedback was largely positive, so we decided to go forward with merged services beginning in June. Once again, the general response has been largely positive and so we have no plans to change back to multiple worship services at this time (unless, of course, we run out of room!).

What are the positives that many people have pointed toward? First and foremost, everyone seems to enjoy seeing the whole congregation at one time. Second, some have commented that the atmosphere is improved with the room being fuller. Third, we've gotten good feedback on the blended approach to music (using both hymns and more recently written spiritual songs almost every week). I've been so proud of our congregation for their willingness to try some news things and adjust! Some churches probably would have had a whole lot more grumbling over changes!

Of course, we've also heard some concerns about the new format. First, a few people have commented that parts of the service are too loud (especially those using hearing aids). Second, some preferred their previous service time because of their morning and early afternoon schedules. We recognize these concerns and intend to continue to tweak sound issues going forward as necessary and aim for a standard end point for our worship service. We will continue to receive feedback and may make a tweak or two going forward if necessary, but the fact that the positives have outweighed the negatives means we will continue with the current schedule for the foreseeable future.

Will Pastor Nathan be replaced?

You can never really 'replace' a minister. Every minister brings a unique gift-mix and personality. We were blessed to have Nathan and his family with us for almost exactly 5 years. Even if we brought in a new full-time staff member with the exact same job description, it would be a very different ministry for sure.

Here's the plan. We have sought to fill the holes left behind from Pastor Nathan's departure with in-house ministers as best as possible. We have found people willing to step into leadership roles for Sunday School and Youth Group. With a plan in place to fill those big holes, we are no longer in an urgent situation. I believe we are better equipped to make a growthoriented hire when we're not working from a situation of urgency. Now, we can use the next several months to prayerfully consider what ministry role would best enhance our overall ministry and we can carefully consider people that emerge for those positions.

In mid-September, we will be bringing in Pastor AJ Thomas to preach and provide us with some coaching and collaboration for our staff search. Please be praying for AJ, our church board, and myself as we prayerfully seek God's will in this area. We aim to be open to wherever God's Spirit leads.


Starting September 8 in Room #17, Cheryl Johnson will be leading the group in studying Knowledge and Wisdom from God's Word.


Her team includes her husband, Joe Waters, as well as veteran helpers Andrea Fitch, Phoebe Rignall, and Josiah Steele.
